### ALL CATHOLICS TO GET A SAY IN POPE'S EXPANDED SYNOD OF BISHOPS' PROCESS

The Pope has asked all dioceses around the world to start consulting with parishioners from October 17 to get local-level views that bishops will take to the XVI Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome in 2023.

"The Holy Father wants to hear the voices of all the baptised," said Cardinal John Dew, the Archbishop of Wellington. "He believes the time is ripe for a wider participation of the people of God in a decision-making process that affects the whole Church and everyone in it."
